## PAC events/fundraisers VOLUNTEERS NEEDED!!!

**Hot Lunch (every Tuesday and one Friday/month)** - The Hot Lunch fundraiser is the school's second largest fundraising event. It is organized and run by PAC to give parents an alternate lunch option once a week. Foodie Kids is the current vendor but there are also others, such as sushi and pizza Friday, that are added to the menu. This service is made possible by parent volunteers who deliver to meals to each division.

**Harvest Bundle** - This fundraiser is operated through the BC Agriculture in the Classroom Foundation to promote heathy eating. Families can purchase locally grown seasonal vegetables and fruit bundles (depending on availability). Intermediate students also participate by helping assemble the bundles.

**Bake Sale (Oct. 19 / Mar. 16)** – Every UHE student will have the opportunity to try a tasty treat during the bake sale. UHE families donate the delicious goodies, which are nut free. Gluten and dairy free options are also available.

**Pumpkin Carving (end of October)** - Each student receives a pumpkin to carve in the classroom through the generous donations from Nesters Market. Parent volunteers help students with the carving.

**Santa's Breakfast (Dec. 19)** - To celebrate the holiday, parent volunteers treat the students to a delicious pancake breakfast with Santa paying a little visit.

**School Carnival (Jun. 2)** - The carnival is the school's largest fundraising event where UHE families, UniverCity and neighbouring residents come together for a day of fun, while raising money for the school. Last year's carnival consisted of pony rides, food truck, silent auctions, midway games, cake walk Nesters BBQ, fire trucks, transit police, exhibitors and much more.

Teacher Appreciation Lunch (June 13th) - Teachers are treated to a lovely appreciation lunch at Nesters.

**Sports Day Concession (June - TBD)** - PAC helps at Sports Day by providing a concession stand for students during morning recess. Students can purchase snacks, such as chip bags and candies for a nominal fee. Each child is also given a frozen fruit freezies and water during the event.
