Welcome back! I hope you all have had a restful and enjoyable summer break! The staff and I have been back in the building this week unpacking our classrooms and getting set up so we can welcome your children back to school. I have some information to share with you about what to expect next week:

First Day- Tuesday, September 8th

Who: Returning Students in Grades 1-7

When: 8:50(welcome bell)-10:00am dismissal

- Please line up at the same place you lined up last year. If your child is returning to UHE but not able to attend on the first day, it is VERY important that you call the school (604-296-9036) or email the office at (UniversityHighlands.Info@burnabyschools.ca) to let us know.

Who: New UHE Students in Grades 1-7

When: 10:30-11:30am

- New UHE students in grades 1-7 (and their parents/guardians- you're invited, too!) please meet our staff in the library, which is just through the front entrance by the flagpole. Our school principal, Ms. Holliday, as well as other members of staff will be there to meet you, tell you about our school, and give you a tour.

Who: Kindergarten Students

When: 11:00am-12:00pm (A-M) OR 1:00-2:00pm (N-Z)

- Welcome to UHE! Kindergarten students are invited to join us for a meet and greet at the Outdoor Learning Area

Wednesday, September 9th – Friday, September 11th

Regular School Hours: 8:50am (welcome bell) – 3:00pm (dismissal bell)

Who: Returning students:

- Meet last year's teacher at their line-up spot. After attendance, students will be moved into **temporary** groups and assigned a **temporary** homeroom teacher for the remainder of the first week, or until we are ready to move into our permanent classes.
- On Wednesday, all students will be dismissed from the rainbow crosswalk area
- Students will bring home **temporary** room/teacher information, with their line up location and dismissal spot for the remainder of the week.

Who: New UHE students:

- Line up by the flagpole (near the front office) Wednesday morning. Staff will bring them to their **temporary** classes for the remainder of the week.
- They will be dismissed from the rainbow crosswalk and will have a paper that will indicate their drop off and pick up locations for the remainder of the week.

Who: Kindergarten students:

- Begin their Welcoming Conversations and gradual entry as scheduled.

****We hope to receive district approval and move into our permanent classes early in week 2.**

In addition, students will need a pair of runners for their physical education classes in the gym.

Students need to bring a fillable water bottle, a small healthy snack, and lunch each day. Please avoid sending in peanuts/nuts as many students have serious allergies. Information about the PAC hot lunch program will be shared soon.
