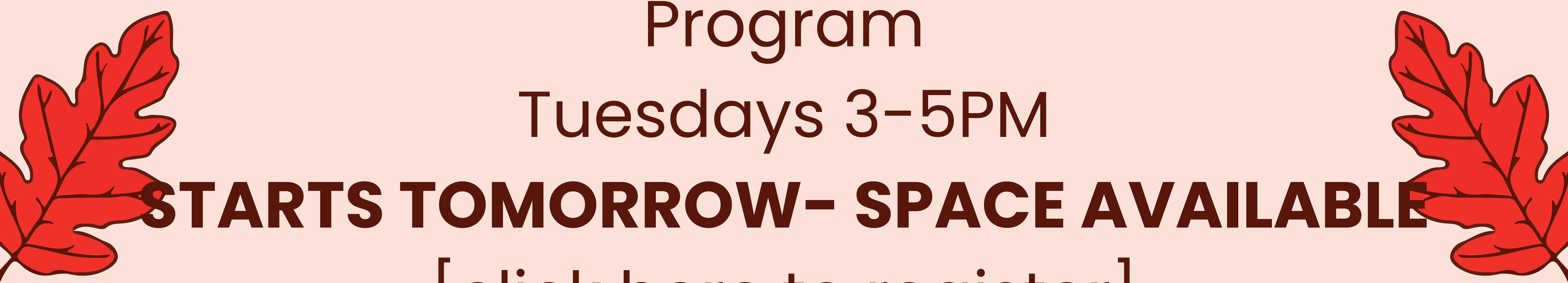

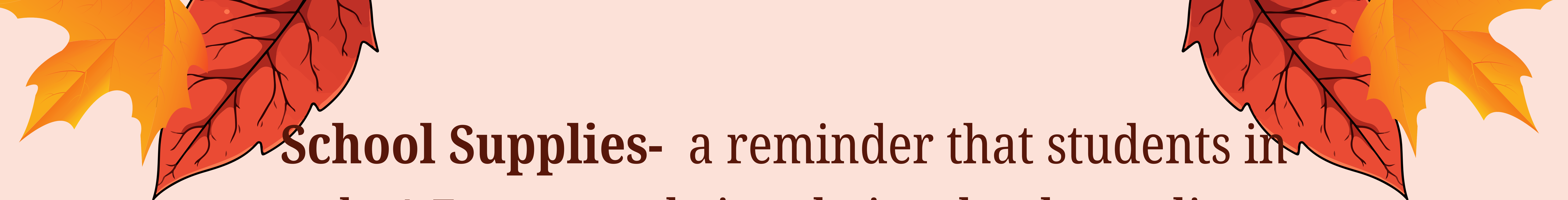

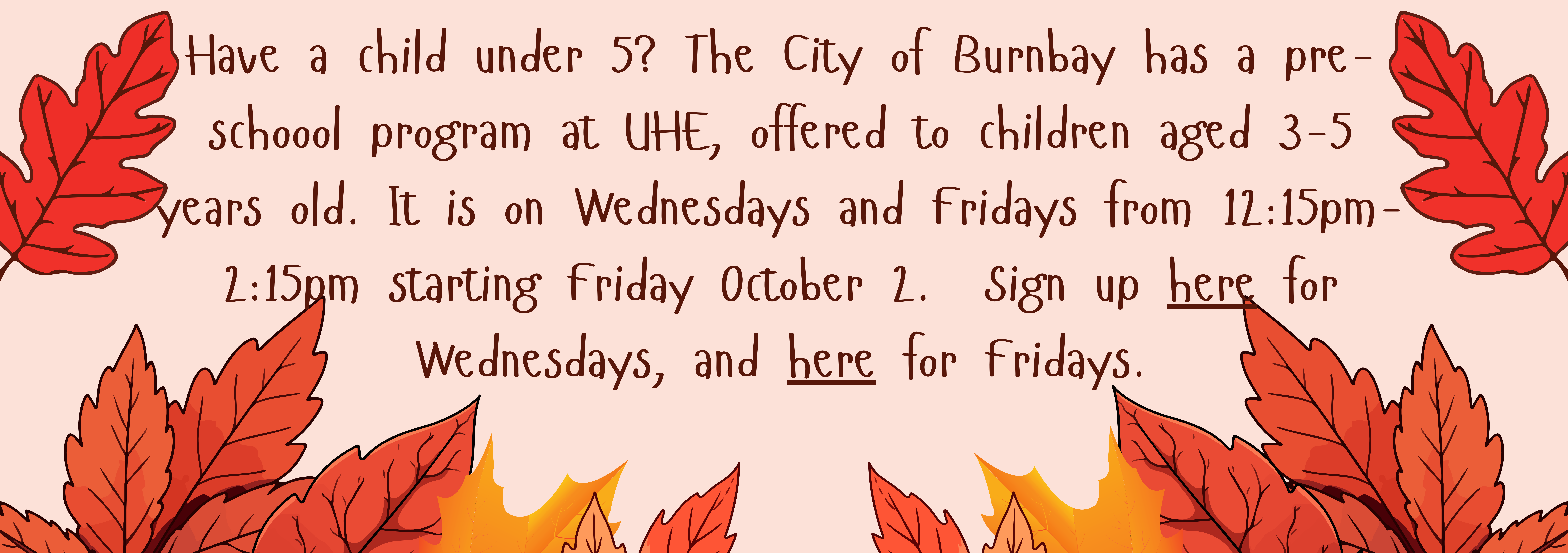


School Supplies- a reminder that students in grade 4-7 can now bring their school supplies to school
